## Saving Money is Easy: October

Question 1: You count your money and have \$17.43. Your dad gives you your allowance. Now you have \$24.93. How much was your allowance?

## Abswer 1: \$24.93 - 17.43 \$ 7.50 Your allowance was \$7.50.

Question 2: Some neighbors gave you change in your Halloween bag. You got 14 dimes, 3 nickels and 10 pennies. How much money did you get?

Abswer 2: To figure this out, find out how much you have for each type of coin, and then add the amounts together.

## **Step 1:**

 $14 \ge 10 = $1.40$  $3 \ge 5 = $0.15$  $10 \ge 1 = $0.10$ 

Step 2: Add the amounts together:

\$1.40	
0.15	
+0.10	
\$1.65	You got \$1.65!

Question 3: You have been saving money for a month. You started with \$7.45. You added your allowance of \$4.50 and your birthday money of \$25.00. Plus you found some change that added up to \$0.84. How much money do you have now?

## Answer 3:

\$ 7.45 4.50 25.00 <u>+ .84</u> \$37.79 You have \$37.79.
